
- 1. To help students distinguish between values and skills, and understand the need, basic guidelines, content and process of value education.






Dr.S.Rajasekaran, Professor, VBIT, Hyderabad presenting about human values on 18.05.2021


Webinar on "Fears of Start-up what to do?"




