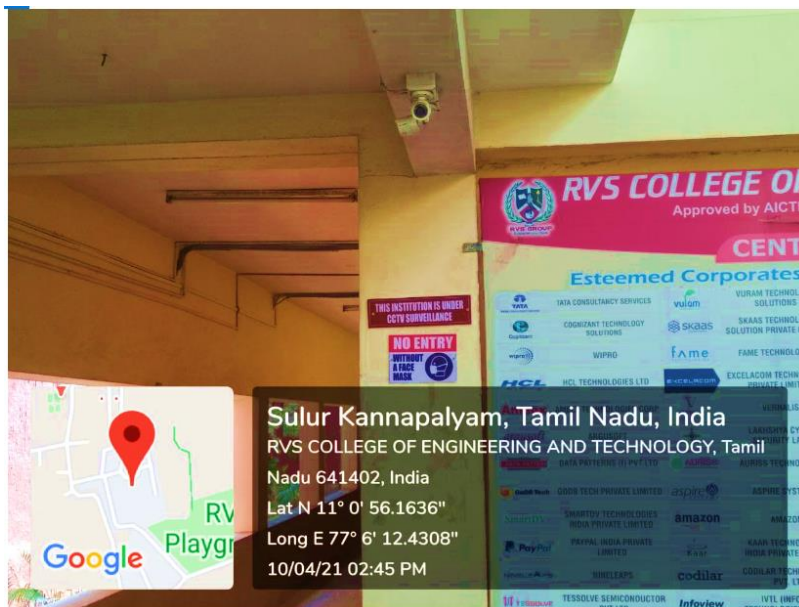

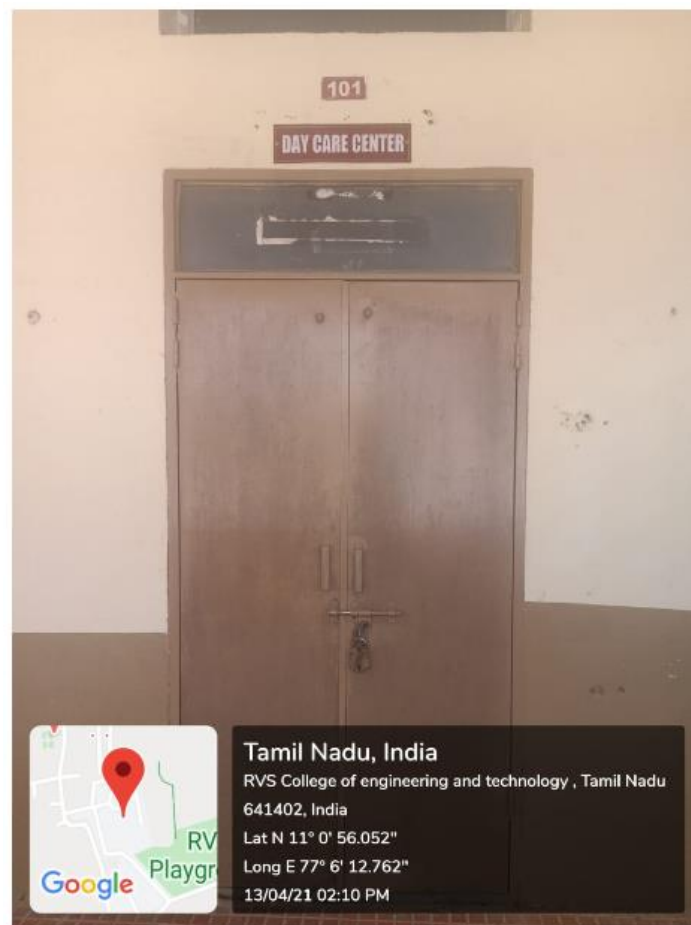
Boys Common Room

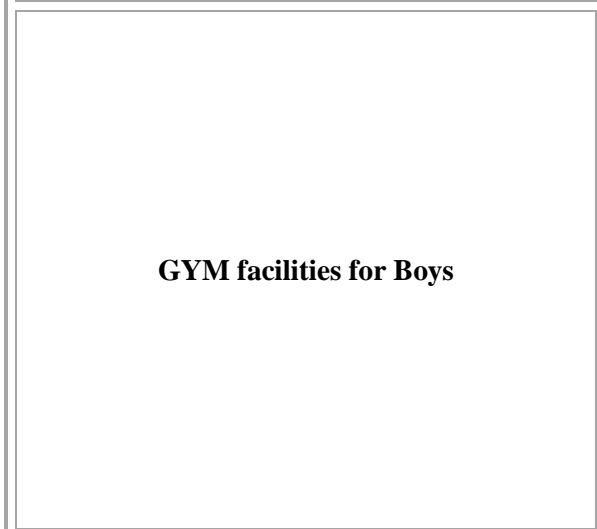



Safe and Health Smart Charger

Project Description:

Preventing mobile phone accident due to phone charger by detecting and control mechanism.

In order to minimize the over temperature, pressure and charging we have planned to implement the system as below:

Detecting of mobile phone usage, charger system will automatically turn off and resume its charging process when not used. With the help of Mobile application incoming and outgoing calls are detected. On sensing the call, mobile charger cut-off automatically and resume its charging when the call is hanged up. Our proposed system also detects the load connected to the end, if there is no load connected then the system will cut-off, and when the battery charge reaches 100% it cut-off and resumes when it is below 100%, the system resumes charging.
